1.4 Voluntary work:

All Directors, Advisers and Members of Working Groups are voluntary workers and there are no salaried staff in our organization. All volunteer workers have to pay for their own travelling and lodging expenses while in Hong Kong or on trips to the Mainland.

2. Finance

2.1 Income – Our source of income includes donations, membership fees and bank interests. Some donors set up special accounts or funds to put in donations regularly, e.g. Xiaoping Education Fund, Chan Dang Social Service Fund, Koo Tin Lok Charity Fund, Yan Society Charity, Chan Ho Shing Account, Chow Tak Fung Account, Chi Hong Nunnery Account, Ching Kin Account, Castle Peak Lions Account, Financial Free Fellowship Account, Lam Chiu Kau Account, Ling Kwong Account, Luen Woo Account, Mong Sam Monk Account, Ng Hung Yuet Ying Account, Pui Chi Account, Sai Wai Education Account, Sik Kwan Account, Sheung Ping Account, Wing Wah Group Account, Wong Wing Cheung Account, Yue Charm Ying Account, Luen Sing Account, Lo Wai Ching Account, Ng Yue Ying Account, Wong Ping Sang Account, Madam Yeung Education Account, Sam Wai Wong Shi Charity Fund, etc. All our receipts come through our bank account and official receipts are issued. Donations of \$100 or more are tax deductible.

2.2 Expenditure – All records of receipts and expenses can be said to be 100% transparent (as evidenced by iDonate). Every item of expenditure is effected by cheque or remittance. Payment bills are approved by two directors for specific purposes. Accounts are audited annually by Certified Public Accountants.

3. Projects:

Projects in recent years:

- Construction of school buildings – a platform is established for the participation of frontline volunteers. From 2000 to 2016, 1,361 premises built.
- Construction of playgrounds, toilets, canteens, bathrooms, etc.—180 projects since 2000.
- Subsidizing primary and secondary students – already helped 16,729 in the last 10 years. Ceased since 2007 due to the government policy of “2 fee-waivers with subsidy for living” for primary and lower secondary students.
- Subsidizing poor senior secondary students – already helped 27,889 from 2005 to 2016.
- Subsidizing teachers college students – already helped 7,991 students from 2004 to 2016.
- Subsidizing tertiary students – already helped 6,962 students from 2001 to 2016.
- Constructing village clinics – already built 297 clinics from 2007 to 2016.
- Building water cellars – already built 3,706 from 2010 to 2016.
- Donated library books to schools – helped 1,721 schools from 2004 to 2016 and 26 community libraries as well.
- Subsidizing orphans and specially poor children –12,422 from 2000 to 2016.
- Helping 1,727 needy teachers from 2000 to 2016.
- Visited 18 elderly homes and 525 individual elders from 2012 to 2016.
- In 2008 rebuilding schools after the May 12 earthquake in Sichuan and relief to snow storm victims in Guizhou.

4. Future projects:

Our future projects largely depend on the reports of frontline workers who gather information from local source or on visits to various places in the poor districts in mainland China. They also passed on information and

Since there is no rent or salaries to pay, the administrative expenses of our organization can be kept to a very low level.
